## Regulatory Update...

**Hormone disruptors** were found in the blood and urine of twenty teenagers in a test sponsored by the Environmental Working Group. The chemicals identified included phthalates, triclosan, and musks which the EWG associates with cosmetics. The girls tested used an average of more than sixteen cosmetic products a day. The Personal Care Products Council has commented that the EWG has picked only data that supports its program and does not provide the complete account of the scientific research on the subject. 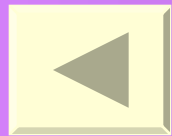
A similar situation is developing between PCPC and Stacy Malkan, author of *Not Just a Pretty Face: The Ugly Side of the Beauty Industry*. Malkan, a spokesperson for The Campaign for Safe Cosmetics, says that Congresswoman Jan Schakowsky (D-Illinois) is writing a bill that would impose **more federal regulation on cosmetics**. The Campaign for Safe Cosmetics advocates mandatory safety testing, full ingredient disclosure, completely banning some chemicals, and giving FDA more authority over the cosmetics industry. Kathleen Dezio, PCPC spokesperson, calls Malkan "an anti-chemical activist" and says that she is "cherry picking of the science to support a political agenda" and does not have "a purely scientific perspective."

PCPC has presented the results of its preliminary survey of **nanomaterials** used in cosmetics to the FDA. The survey was a joint effort of PCPC's International Cooperation on Cosmetic Regulation and the association partners Colipa, Japan Cosmetic Industry Association and the Canadian CTFA. PCPC believes the survey, though called a "preliminary inventory," contains the vast majority of nanomaterials currently used in cosmetics. The Council is committed to a second survey to try to involve all members of each association. PCPC expects to have the results of its first **sustainability** survey available to participating members in November.

If Representative John Dingell (D-Mich.) and Senator Chuck Grassley (R-Iowa) have their way, the FDA may have its most significant **overhaul** ever in 2009, providing the Agency with much broader powers than it currently has and the appointment of a tough FDA commissioner completely independent from the drug industry. Sen. Grassley says FDA officials are "too cozy with the companies they regulate."
